

## Advanced ALC Syllabus

AOS's **Advanced Arabic Language Course** is designed for students with substantial prior knowledge of written and spoken Arabic, ranging from GCSE-level ability to university level Arabic. The course has the primary aim of promoting cultural exchange through the opportunity to learn and practice Arabic.

The Advanced presumes that students are able to hold conversations in Arabic and gives students a chance to practice their Arabic weekly, covering a range of topics and tasks including:

- Current issues of the Arab world, comedy and cultural issues
- Simple passages from easy-to-read novels or stories
- Some areas of grammar
- News articles and how to translate them and discuss them in Arabic
- Written Arabic homework on a short text they have read
- Weekly translation or assignments (Arabic to English and English to Arabic)
- End of course mini project translation

Please note the content covered each lesson will vary depending on the students' abilities. It is common for the students in each class to have differing levels of Arabic knowledge, so our teacher works around this to ensure every student gets as much as possible out of the classes.
