

Beginners Level 1 ALC Syllabus

AOS's **Beginners Level 1 Arabic Language Course** will give you a brief introduction to written and spoken Arabic. The course has the primary aim of promoting cultural exchange through the opportunity to learn and practice Arabic.

The Beginners Level 1 Course covers:

- Greetings
- How to introduce yourself (who you are, where you come from, where you live, your profession)
- How to introduce others (you/he/she pronouns and conjugations, nationalities)
- Daily activities (some verbs and nouns)
- Transliterating proper nouns
- Numbers
- Office, leisure, family and weather vocabulary
- Possessive suffixes
- Feminine and masculine forms of nouns

You will learn a few letters per lesson and how to join them as well as vowel markers. In each lesson, you will practice reading, listen to and repeat phrases and you will use the grammar and vocab to construct your own short sentences. You will learn how to ask and answer questions.

Please note the content covered each less will vary depending on the students' abilities.

The course roughly follows Gateway to Arabic Book 1, which will be emailed to enrolled students before the start of term.
