

Beginners Level 2 ALC Syllabus

AOS's **Beginners Level 2 Arabic Language Course** will give those with little knowledge of Arabic a brief introduction to written and spoken Arabic. The course has the primary aim of promoting cultural exchange through the opportunity to learn and practice Arabic.

The Beginners Level 2 Course covers:

- Question words (what; which; where; who; how much; when)
- Numbers 1-100
- Everyday objects and activities (verbs and nouns)
- Conjugating verbs (singular form) in present tense and 'he' form in past tense (root verb)
- Transliterating proper nouns and borrowed words (e.g. computer; television)
- Ordering food and drink
- Directions
- Possessive suffixes practice with different nouns (e.g. your pen; her pen; our pen)
- Introduction to time

In each lesson, you will practice reading letters (joined up and separate) with vowel markers and shaddah (شَدَة) (emphasis/double letter marker), listen to and repeat phrases and you will use the grammar and vocab to construct your own short sentences. You will learn how to ask and answer questions.

Please note the content covered each less will vary depending on the students' abilities.

The course roughly follows Gateway to Arabic Book 1 and 2, which will be emailed to enrolled students before the start of term.
