

Beginners Level 3 ALC Syllabus

AOS's **Beginners Level 3 Arabic Language Course** will give those with some basic knowledge of Arabic the chance to develop their written and spoken Arabic. The course has the primary aim of promoting cultural exchange through the opportunity to learn and practice Arabic.

The Beginners Level 3 Course covers:

- Question words "متى", "كم", "أي", "كيف", "من", "هل and متى" على " أي", "كيف" من " أي " من" أي " أي " أي " أي
- Answering questions in present and past tense
- Numbers to 999
- Everyday objects and activities (verbs and nouns)
- Past tense using first, second and third person singular with pronouns
- 2D and 3D mathematical shapes
- The dual form, "بیتان" and "قلمان
- Adjectives (building on existing knowledge, widening vocabulary)
- Practice everyday phrases using words that co-occur frequently in Arabic, e.g. "I play with a ball", "I carry a bag", "I read a book every month", "I write with a pen on paper" etc so they become natural

In each lesson, you will practice reading Arabic words and phrases with vowel markers and shaddah (شَدَة) (emphasis/double letter marker), you will listen to and repeat phrases and you will use the grammar and vocab to construct your own short sentences.

Please note the content covered each lesson will vary depending on the students' abilities.

The course roughly follows Gateway to Arabic Book 2, which will be emailed to enrolled students before the start of term.
